



SPRING 2008 SEASON TEAM INFORMATION

We have summarized the key policies and procedures that teams are to follow for the 2007/2008 Indiana Soccer League (ISL) season. The complete ISL Rules are available at www.IndianaSoccerLeague.org.

TEAM ROSTERS

All teams must submit an official **ISL Team Roster** of players no later than July 15 (fall) and/or January 15 (spring). Revisions and additions can be made following Indiana Youth Soccer registration rules. An authorized official from the Indiana Youth Soccer must authorize the validity of the rostered players.

GUEST PLAYERS

Up to a total of seven (7) Guest players are allowed per team per season, provided that the guest players are in accordance with 12.5 of the ISL Rules. All teams must submit additions to their official **ISL Player Roster** no later than three (3) days prior to the team's scheduled game. An authorized official from Indiana Youth Soccer must authorize the validity of the ISL Guest Player Roster in conjunction with the ISL rules. Guest players must be submitted online. The total number of players that can be rostered to a team is twenty-five (25) including guest players.

LINE-UP GAME CARDS and PLAYER PASSES

Each team must bring their laminated US Youth Soccer member passes signed by an official of Indiana Youth Soccer, and two (2) copies of an their **OFFICIAL ISL LINE-UP GAME CARDS** to every match. Game cards are available at the ISL website and 2 copies must be printed for each game. Official ISL Lineup Game Cards are to be given to the referee and the opposing coach prior to the start of a match.

UNIFORM COLOR CONFLICT

Rule Updated – 1-7-2008 – The home team must wear a white/light color jersey and the visiting team must wear a dark color jersey. If the referee determines the uniforms are too similar and may cause confusion, the offending team must change their jersey to comply with the color requirements.

REFEREE FEES

Referee Fees are to be paid prior to the match. Each team will pay ½ the referee fees at each match. Teams should bring the appropriate breakdown of cash. Referees are not to be expected to make change.

U13/U14 – Center 40/ AR's 30/30 Each team brings \$50.00
U15/U18 – Center 50/ AR's 35/35 Each team brings \$60.00

MATCH LENGTH

U13/U14: 2x35-minute halves U15/U16: 2x40-minute halves U17/U18: 2x45-minute halves

SEND OFFS AND SUSPENSIONS

With teams playing multiple games during a weekend, team managers and coaches are expected to self-enforce all suspensions. On all Send Offs, the player and expulsions, the coach or team official, must not participate in that team's next scheduled ISL game. A team that plays an ineligible player shall be subject to disciplinary action including, but not limited to: forfeiture of the match, suspension of the team's coach from ISL competition, or expulsion of the team from the ISL.

GAME CHANGES

No game can be rescheduled without the written permission of the ISL Commissioner.
